



NHBC 2017 Consecration Month

It's here! The 2017 **“first fruits consecration month”** has arrived! The Lord has kept us safe and provided for us 365 days and I look forward each year to dedicating the first fruit of the first month of the year unto the Lord. For **21** days, starting at **12:01** AM January the **2nd** and ending the **22nd**; we want every **NHBC** member to sacrifice by fasting and praying. Each year we offer this consecration as the will of God for the church! Again, I remind us all that the **21** days of spiritual consecration is our opportunity to get our family members, our friends and co-workers who are not a part of the **NHBC** congregation to participate in our consecration month. This consecration can be a great time to build relationships as you share the word of God and encourage people who never fast to worship the Lord with you. Remember, prayer is an important aspect of our consecration and we must commit to prayer also. Our prayer and fasting times will start each day beginning at **6:00AM** and end each day at **6:00 PM!** We ask that if possible you spend as much time praying during this period as possible. We want to commit our lives to sacrifice and seeking the face of God for His divine will and plan for us all during the entire year of 2017.

I warn you to be alert to the enemy's tactics, so that he does not trip you up as you make this great sacrifice. The word tells us in *2 Corinthians 2:11*, *“so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes”*. Each year at the very outset, the enemy seek ways to get some people to rebel and not participate in this corporate church consecration. Satan does not want us to unite and enjoy harmony within the church. The enemy does not want us to prosper and be in health as our soul prospers according to *3 John 1:2*. In order to successfully accomplish this year's consecration goal, you must trust God and let him lead you as you participate. Just like last year and in previous years, I want you to seek the Lord on what he would have you to give up during the fast. I will list some things for us to give up and what we can pray for, but the Holy Spirit is your best guide. Use your daily confession to speak into existence the promises of God for your life. The bible teaches that the power of death and life is in your tongue, so for the next **21** days confess life for this year and the years to come. As you confess the word of God over your life, be in expectation as you wait on the performance. Our consecration instructions will be available for you December 31st and you can pick one up at the usher's station. We will also have them available online on our church website. As always, thank you for your participation during this year's consecration. Blessings and miracles to you all year long!

Fast Instructions

What you can eat and drink for 21 days

- MEATS: Fish, Chicken, Turkey (poultry of any kind), shell fish (any seafood) (Baked, Broiled or Grilled meats Only)
- You can have any Vegetables...potatoes, beans, greens, etc.
- For Breakfast...grits, oatmeal, eggs, fruit, plain biscuits, toast, bagel
- Water, milk and Fruit Juice of any kind
- Natural fruits only

What you specifically cannot have for 21 days

- No sweets, deserts (cakes or pies), candy, cookies, pastries, ice cream, etc
- No sodas, coffee, tea, or caffeine of any kind
- Nothing fried (fried chicken, french fries, fried okra, fried chips, etc.).
- No red meats of any kind (see allowed meats)

Additional Fast areas

- No television, radio, other music devices, internet, texting, twitter, Instagram, social media of any type (unless job requirement) between the hours of 6:00 AM-6:00 PM daily
- No excessive spending (buying clothing, no expensive purchases of any kind, at mall or online, etc.,) beyond your normal household budget, except in a real emergency during 21 days.

Please use your time reading the bible or spiritual help materials during the times you would be on the internet or texting.

NHBC 21Day Faith Confessions

Your tongue is a very powerful instrument. It can either call down blessings from heaven or bring curses (failure) into your life. The Bible says, "*Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof*" (Proverbs 18:21).

If there are areas in your life that needs changing, your tongue is the best tool to use to bring about that transformation. Make the following confessions daily, be in constant expectation and the promises of God will manifest in your life.

Day 1 NHBC

- A. This is the set time of favor for New Hope Baptist Church (NHBC) and the body of Christ (Psalm 102:13).
- B. This ministry inherits the souls of millions who are spiritually lost (Psalms 2:8).
- C. NHBC operates in integrity and shows favor to others; it guides its affairs with discretion (Psalm 112:5).
- D. As a kingdom ministry, NHBC, it's leaders, and outreach Ministries are blessed and favored of God to expand its outreach without hindrances of any kind (Deuteronomy 33:23; Isaiah 54:2-3).
- E. Partners and members of NHBC are blessed and highly favored because of their faithful support of and association with this ministry (Exodus 12:36; 1 Corinthians 9:11-14, 23; Philippians 1:7; 4:10-19).
- F. NHBC has everything needed to fulfill God's perfect will. God adds to this church family daily, so NHBC has thousands of committed, active and faithful members (Acts 2:47).
- G. NHBC members are faithful with the little (Luke 19:17). They are 100-percent tithers; as such, they are connected to God's power and receive a 100-fold return on the seed they sow.

Day 2 Family

- A. God's favor causes my family to increase more and more (Psalm 115:14).
- B. **(For the Husband to say):**
 - o My wife is blessed and highly favored among women (Luke 1:28).
 - o She is a virtuous woman who prospers in everything she does at home, work, in business and in other affairs (Proverbs 31:10-31).
 - o My relationship with my wife is good; together we have obtained the favor of the Lord (Proverbs 18:22).
- C. **(For the Wife to say):**
 - o My husband is blessed and highly favored among men because God is with him (Genesis 39:2; Luke 1:28).
 - o He sits in places of authority among other leaders (Proverbs 31:23).
- D. My children are blessed and well-favored of God. They are skillful and wise, and they stand before kings (Daniel 1:4-5, 9).
- E. Like Jesus, my children increase in wisdom, stature and favor with God and men (Luke 2:52; 1 Samuel 2:26; 16:22).

Day 3 Protection

- A. In my prosperity, I am like a mountain that cannot be moved (Psalm 30:6-7; 112:6-8).
- B. The Lord has granted me long life and favor, and has preserved my spirit from destruction (Job 10:12).
- C. God is pleased with me and His favor endures for a lifetime (Psalm 30:5, AMP).
- D. I declare that no matter what happens around me, I have a covenant of peace with God and His love, kindness and favor will never depart from me (Isaiah 54:10, 14-17; 1 Samuel 25:6).
- E. God surrounds and protects me with favor like a shield (Psalm 5:12).
- F. Fear cannot rule in my life because I have favor with God (Luke 1:30).
- G. My enemies cannot triumph over me because the Lord has favored me (Psalm 41:11).

Day 4 Prosperity

- A. Jesus is the Apostle and High Priest over my profession, and what I profess is the Word of God concerning favor over my life (Hebrews 3:1).
- B. The Lord helps me to guard the door of my mouth and trains me not to speak against His favor at work in my life (Psalm 141:3, *AMP*).
- C. I will not allow any corrupt communication to proceed out of my mouth. Instead, I will speak only that which is good, full of grace and edifying to others (Ephesians 4:29).
- D. As the righteousness of God, I declare that I am favorable in God's sight (Job 33:26, *AMP*; Psalm 5:12; Proverbs 14:9).
- E. Like Joseph, I prosper wherever I go and in every situation I am in because the Lord is always with me. I, too, experience preferential treatment (Genesis 39:1-6, 21).
- F. I am blessed and highly favored (Luke 1:28).
- G. I associate with those who are blessed and highly favored so that I may increase in every area of my life (Genesis 30:27).
- H. I operate in integrity; as a result, I obtain favor from God (Proverbs 11:27; 12:2).
- I. I actively seek and live by God's wisdom; therefore, I am highly favored and esteemed in the sight of God and men (Proverbs 3:1-4; 8:33-35).
- J. I declare that God's favor promotes and causes me to increase daily (Esther 2:17; Psalm 75:6-7).
- K. The Lord takes pleasure in my total life prosperity (Psalm 35:27).
- L. Because I am God's "favorite," I prosper in every area of my life-spiritually, physically, financially, socially and mentally (3 John 2).
- M. Because the favor of God shields me, no sickness or disease has a right to live in my body (Deuteronomy 7:15; Psalm 5:12).
- N. Wealth and riches are in my house because I am empowered with His anointing and favor to draw wealth (Deuteronomy 8:18; Psalm 112:3).

Day 5 Healing

- A. Thank you Father, for sending Your Word to deliver me from destruction (Psalm 107:20).
- B. Jesus bore my griefs (pains) and carried my sorrows (sicknesses). He was pierced through for my transgressions and crushed for my iniquities. The punishment for my well-being fell on Him, and by His stripes I am healed (Isaiah 53:4-5; 1 Peter 2:24).
- C. Father, your words are life to me. They are healing and health to all my flesh (Proverbs 4:22, *AMP*).
- D. Since the Spirit of Him Who raised Christ Jesus from the dead dwells in me, that same Spirit also gives life to my body (Romans 8:11).
- E. Thank you Father God that I prosper and am in health even as my soul prospers (3 John 2).
- F. Lord, you restore my health and heal my wounds (Jeremiah 30:17).
- G. Thank you Lord, for forgiving all of my iniquities and healing all of my diseases (Psalm 103:3).
- H. Thank you Father, that my light breaks forth as the morning and that my health springs forth speedily (Isaiah 58:8).

Day 6 Hearing From God

Heavenly Father, I declare that I possess a hearing heart. I hear from You in specific detail, not in vague impressions. Every word I hear from You empowers me to prosper and excel. I stand firm in You, Lord. Because I am established in righteousness, the gates of hell do not prevail against me. Speak to me concerning what I need to do to live for You and experience the reality of Your blessings in my life. I obey You in all things; therefore, Your Word always comes to pass in my life.

I am Your sheep and You are my Shepherd. I know Your voice, and the voice of a stranger I do not follow. I hear Your voice clearly and obey immediately. In Jesus name, Amen!

Jesus came to the earth to restore the blessing that Adam lost in the Garden of Eden when he sinned and because I am a child of God, I have a covenant right to the blessing! I declare that like Abraham, I am blessed to be a blessing until all families of the earth are blessed. Because of the blessing of God on my life, I am empowered to prosper in every endeavor that I take on and every project that I begin. I am blessed on my job and all my relationships are blessed. Like Joseph, those in authority over me see the blessing of God on my life and I have favor as a result. Thank You, Lord, for blessing me with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places. Day 11 Healthy Living

Your words are the building blocks to a better life. Use them to establish a strong foundation where your health is concerned. Your health is subject to change for the better when you speak healing rather than sickness over your physical body.

In the name of Jesus, I declare that my body is the temple of the Holy Ghost, and I glorify God with it. I present a healthy body to God and discipline myself not to overeat. I only eat food that promotes health. The life of God flows through my spirit, soul and body, and brings healing to every fiber of my being. I am redeemed from the curse of the law, and no weapon of sickness or disease formed against me will prosper.

In the name of Jesus, I declare that I cultivate temperance by subjecting my mind and body to God's Word. I cast down every negative thought about my appearance that attempts to exalt itself against the knowledge of God and His will for my life. I exhibit self-control, diligence, wisdom and patience regarding my exercise regimen and what I eat. I walk in the Spirit and not in the flesh. I put to death the unhealthy desires of my body. Jesus is Lord over my eating habits. I am more than a conqueror, and I can do all things through Christ who empowers me. I release most holy faith to bring these things to pass in my life and charge my angels to carry out each assignment. My words have creative ability, and in the name of Jesus, I have what I say. Day 13 Our Nation

- A. In the name of Jesus, I declare that this nation is blessed of the Lord, and no weapon formed against these United States shall prosper (Isaiah 54:17).
- B. This country is filled with people who pray and seek God's face. As such, His eyes and ears are attuned to our prayers (2 Chronicles 7:15).
- C. Because unseen, angelic forces are working on behalf of this country, we will be victorious over our enemies (2 Kings 6:16-17).
- D. There is no division among the citizens of this country. We form a united front by praying for our leaders daily (1 Timothy 2:1-3).
- E. I declare that the plans for acts of terrorism are revealed to those who provide our national security (Daniel 11:25).
- F. I am not afraid to travel, because God preserves my going out and my coming in. I carry out my daily affairs secure in the knowledge that I am more than a conqueror (Psalm 121:8; Romans 8:37).
- G. As the righteousness of God, I have authority over my enemies, and nothing will harm me (Luke 10:19).
- H. According to Proverbs 18:21, my words have creative ability; in the name of Jesus, I have what I say. I release most holy faith to bring these things to pass.

Day 14 Military

- A. In the name of Jesus, I declare that the men and women who serve in the Armed Forces dwell in the secret place of the Most High God and abide under the shadow of the Almighty (Psalm 91:1).
- B. The Lord is their Refuge and Fortress. He delivers them from the enemy; therefore, they do not fear the terror in the night or the destruction that takes place at noonday (Psalm 91:2, 5-6).
- C. Thousands may fall around them, but destruction does not come near them (Psalm 91:7).
- D. When they call on the Lord, He immediately answers them. He is with them in trouble; He delivers them and satisfies them with long life (Psalm 91:15-16).
- E. Because the Lord has given His angels charge over them, their spouses and their children, I declare that their lives are redeemed from destruction. No evil comes near them, and neither does any plague come near their homes (Psalm 91:10-11).
- F. I declare that every service member and his or her family walk in favor. They lack no good or beneficial thing, because God supplies all of their needs (Philippians 4:19).
- G. They are whole-there is nothing missing, broken or lacking in their lives. No weapon formed against them shall prosper (Isaiah 54:13, 17).

Day 15 Righteous Identity

Your faith in the blood of Jesus has placed you in right-standing with God. Nothing you could ever do will make you more or less righteous in His sight; you have already been made righteous! As a result, you have every right to experience God's best in your life.

In the name of Jesus, I declare that I am the righteousness of God. I have been released from the bondage of sin and I am free to exercise my rights as a born-again believer. I have a right to prosper in every area of life.

The Word of God is my guarantee that I can speak as God speaks and call into existence everything that I need to succeed. I take authority over sickness, disease, poverty and insufficiency, and I rule as a king in life!

Day 20 Concerning My Mind

- A. I allow the wisdom and knowledge of God to control my thoughts so I can avoid the immoral people who try to seduce me (Proverbs 2:10, 16).
- B. I guard my heart and mind by meditating on God's Word daily. I will not allow any immoral thoughts to stay in my mind. Instead, I cast down every thought that is contrary to God's Word by speaking the Word over my life. I do not look to the right or to the left, but straight ahead to the Word of God (Proverbs 4:23-27; 2 Corinthians 10:4-5).
- C. I will not allow past sins to hinder me from inheriting the blessings of God (Romans 4:7; 1 John 1:9; Acts 26:18; Colossians 1:12-14; Ephesians 1:6-7).
- D. I confess that everything I do, say and think is motivated by the love of God and as a result, I always reap a good harvest. I judge myself so that I will not be judged and when I find that my motives aren't pure, I will immediately repent.

Day 21 Abiding In God

Abiding, or resting in confidence in God, involves fellowshiping with Him through prayer and reading His Word. This helps to build your faith in His ability to do great things in your life. The Father loves to hear your voice speaking His Word in full assurance that His promises will come to pass.

In the name of Jesus, I declare that God is my Father and I have a right to fellowship with Him intimately. Fellowship with Him is the distinguishing mark of my life. His Word strengthens and leads me to prosperity. I abide, rest in and trust the promises outlined in God's Word, and He manifests His goodness in my life. I am connected to my Father's power and I can do all things through the Anointed One and His Anointing Who strengthens me!
